PARADE RULES =

Entries other than Marching Bands

- 1.1 DATE: Saturday, October 27, 2012
- 1.2 ENTRY ARRIVAL: All entries should allow adequate time for arrival and entering the line of march. Each entry will receive notification as to what time to arrive in the staging area. The parade steps off at 9:00am.
- 1.3 CLASSES OF COMPETITION:
 - Class I - General Entries
 - Division A - School
 - Division B - Community
 - Division C - Commercial
 - Class II - Autos and Horseless Carriages
 - Division A - 1934 and Older
 - Division B - 1935 and Newer
 - Division C - Custom/Modified Cars
 - Division D - Car Clubs (limited to 10 entries per club)
 - Class III - Political
 - Division A - All Entries
- 1.4 FORWARD MOVEMENT: For safety reasons and time restraints each entry must move forward at all times in the line of march. There is no stopping in front of the judge's stand and any entrant who does not comply will be prohibited from participating in next year's parade.
- 1.5 AWARDS: Awards will be available at the Senior Center in Lincoln Park shortly after the parade.
- 1.6 CANDY AND OTHER ITEMS: Nothing shall be thrown from floats or vehicles. Any entrant who throws candy or other items will be prohibited from participating in next year=s parade.
- 1.7 AMPLIFIED MUSIC: Amplified music played by any entrant shall not interfere with the music being played by the Marching Bands. At the discretion of the Rotary Parade Marshals you may be asked to turn your music down or off completely. Any entrant who does not comply with Rotary Parade Marshals request will be prohibited from participating in next year=s parade.
- 1.8 FINAL: We are pleased that you have chosen to be a part of this year=s parade. After the competition we will welcome any comments or criticism you wish to make if you will put it in writing.
